RAMBO	10	<p>Added a sentence for clarification.</p> <p>In the event that a judge or authorized photographer accidentally flushes a bird, the hunter will receive full points for that bird (equivalent with a safety). If the bird lands in the competition field, it is considered good luck and can be pursued after (1) 5-minutes have gone by since the safety or (2) another bird was pursued before returning to the safety bird.</p>

Competitor(s) competing in the following run (<i>on deck</i>) cannot watch the bird-set or the run. 5. Competitors should not compete back-to-back in the same field. If it is unavoidable, the competitor must wait for 20-minutes between the end of the first run until they can proceed with the second run.
